### “MAKING GOD KNOWN”

Have you ever been presented with the perfect opportunity to bring something up and speak your mind about an important matter? In broadcast media “segue” is the term used for a bridge between two topics. A good segue allows one topic to flow smoothly into the next. A golden opportunity to bridge a gap came to Paul in our lesson from Acts. He both received an invitation to speak his mind to the philosophers of Athens; and in one of their altars found the perfect touchstone to tell them about Jesus. Paul was always on the lookout for an opportunity to tell people about Jesus.

Paul had seen many temples in Athens. The Greeks had many gods. One altar was even dedicated to “*the unknown god.*” Paul proceeded to make the unknown God known to them as life, love, forgiveness and eternal life; by telling them about Jesus the Saviour, who through His sacrifice did what no other sacrifice in any temple could do; take away the sin of the world. The Holy Spirit never misses an opportunity either. He worked through Paul’s words and created faith in the hearts of some who heard. Luke says, “*Some men joined him and believed...Dionysius...and a woman named Damaris.*” We pray the Holy Spirit to give us the opportunities to speak the words, by which we might make God known as Lord and Saviour in Jesus Christ.

God is unknown to many people. Many who acknowledge His existence, do not know Him personally in love through faith in Jesus. Many people know God as an intellectual concept that has little effect on their lives. Some know God as an angry judge, who watches them and waits for judgement day to condemn them. Through the word and by the illumination of the Holy Spirit, we have come to know God in a different way. We know God in Jesus; as love, mercy, compassion, kindness and forgiveness. John 3:16 “*God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whoever believes in Him would not perish but have eternal life.*” That’s how we know God. That’s how God wants all people to know Him.
