He says: "*They are before the throne of God and serve Him in His temple; and He who sits on the throne will shelter them with His presence. They shall hunger no more, neither thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any scorching heat. For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their shepherd and He will guide them to springs of living water, and God will wipe every tear from their eyes.*" This is the holy place to which our journey leads.
