### Psalm 148

**Hallelujah! Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the heights above.**

Praise Him, all His angels, praise Him all His heavenly hosts.

### **Believing is Seeing**

Thomas wanted proof that Jesus had risen from the dead. For him, seeing was believing. Actually, he had it backwards. Believing is seeing. When we take the gospel to heart and believe what is written, we see that Jesus is risen from the dead. If we need proof of Jesus' resurrection, all we have to do is reflect upon the change in the disciples' disposition after Jesus' resurrection, the suffering they endured for the sake of their testimony and the manner in which their earthly service was concluded; for except John, all including Thomas, died violent deaths because of their faith and testimony to salvation through faith in His Name.

The evening of Easter Sunday found the disciples hiding behind locked doors, fearful of arrest by the Jewish authorities. Two months later these timid, unbelieving, fearful men were standing in the courts of the temple, boldly telling everyone within earshot that Jesus is the Messiah, calling people to faith and saying that there is no other name given under heaven by which we are saved and that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved!

They were arrested, beaten and warned not to preach salvation in Jesus' Name. Their faith was so firm that they refused to back down, even under the threat of death. They said, "We must obey God rather than men. The God of our fathers raised Jesus, whom you killed by hanging Him on a tree. God exalted Him at His right hand as Leader and Saviour to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins." They praised God and rejoiced that "they were counted worthy to suffer disgrace for the Name." What a difference Jesus' resurrection made in their lives! That difference gives us reason to accept their words and with them believe that Jesus is indeed the Christ,

the Son of God. When we believe the words of witness in scripture we see Jesus at work in the world and alive in our hearts!
